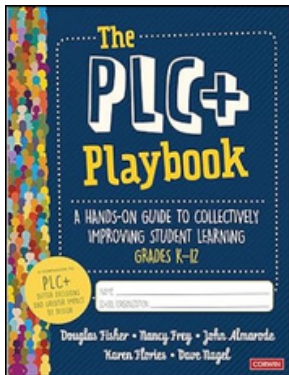

## **iJAG (Iowa Jobs after Graduation)**

- Two full time iJAG instructors: Diana Dahir (7th/8th grades) and Amber Schmitz (high school)
- This is a credited course for high school students. Students may earn 1 credit per semester for a total of 2 credits. This is a middle school elective course.
- Encourage "Employer Engagement" opportunities by hosting one new employer weekly.
- Individualized guidance for job seeking students: assisting with resume writing, job shadowing opportunities, and building interviewing & soft skills.
